The petitioners, claiming themselves to be aged about 19 and 20 years respectively, have approached this Court seeking protection of their life and liberty on the averments that the petitioner No. 1 wants to marry with petitioner No. 2 but the parents of petitioner No. 1 want to marry her with some other boy against her wishes. The petitioners are apprehending threat to their life and liberty from danger at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 7.

Status report by way of affidavit of Manish Kumar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur has already been filed on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3

In the status report, it has been mentioned that statements of the petitioners and statements of respondents No. 4 to 7 were

recorded. Copies of the statements have also been enclosed with the report.

In their statements, the petitioners stated that now they have no danger to their life and liberty from respondents No. 4 to 7 and do not require police security as the parents of petitioner No. 1 are agreed with them.

Respondents No. 4 to 7 in their statements have stated that they are agreed to the marriage of the petitioners and they will not interfere in their married life.

In view of the statements, no further action is required to be taken on the petition which is disposed of as having become infructuous.
