Both the learned counsel have today informed that they could not arrange for video conferencing between petitioner No.1 and respondent No.4 as they could not be contacted on video call. However, learned counsel representing respondent No.4 has fairly stated that his client would not insist upon the same in case petitioner No.1 does not wish to speak to him. He has however requested that petitioner No.1 may be directed to hand over or to disclose the whereabouts of the medical treatment file of respondent No.4 which was earlier being maintained by petitioner No.1.

In view of the aforestated submission, counsel for the petitioner

is requested to advice his client to do the needful as regards the medical treatment file of respondent No.4 so that respondent No.4 does not face any difficulty in getting medical treatment.

As far as the main relief prayed for in this petition is concerned, since both the petitioners are stated to be major, without commenting as regards the veracity of the averments made in the petition and also as regards the validity of alleged marriage of the petitioners, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation dated 10.02.2021 (Annexure P-6) in accordance with law. In case, it is found that there is a genuine threat to the lives and liberty of the petitioners, then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest so as to ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioners.

A copy of this order alongwith copy of the representation dated 10.02.2021 be sent to Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur (respondent No.2), so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.

It is, however, clarified that the aforesaid order shall not be taken to be any expression as regards the validity of marriage of the petitioners and shall not confer any immunity upon the petitioners, in case it is found that they have committed any wrong.
