This is third petition for grant of bail pending trial in criminal case arising from FIR No.82 dated 30.06.2019 registered under Section 22 of NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Bhikhi, District Mansa.

The previous petition filed by the petitioner was dismissed on 21.08.2020 with the following order:-

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner was arrested with 3500 tablets 'tarmosa' containing salt-Tramadol Hydrochloride. Thereafter, on the disclosure statement of the petitioner, another batch of 1000 tablets was recovered. The trial of the case has already commenced as the prosecution has recorded statements of 4 prosecution witnesses.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.

Learned counsel representing the State has informed the Court that trial had already commenced and four prosecution witnesses have already been examined. In view thereof, no ground to grant bail is made out.

Dismissed.

However, the learned trial Court is requested to expedite the trial.
