The instant appeal has been filed by Nidhi -complainant against the judgment dated 29.3.2014 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Jhajjar, whereby all the six accused (her husband, her in-laws and Dr. Archana Jaiswal) have been acquitted of the charges framed against them in case FIR No. 310 dated 12.8.2009 under Sections 312, 313, 120-B IPC, PS City Bahadurgarh, for allegedly having committed forcible abortion of the complainant in connivance with each other.

The appeal stands admitted vide order dated 4.11.2014.

Now CRM No.3622 of 2021 along with an affidavit dated 9.2.2021 has been filed by the complainant- appellant to withdraw the said appeal in view of the compromise arrived at between the parties.

In the application, it is averred that as per compromise arrived at between her and her estranged husband, both have decided to withdraw cases filed by them against each other, which also includes the instant appeal. Copy of the order dated 25.1.2021 passed by the Court of Family Court, Sonapat, is annexed with the application as Annexure A1, wherein reference has been made to the statement of the parties in this regard.

Notice of the application.

Ms. Shruti Jain Goyal, learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice and states that she has no objection if the present application is allowed and the main appeal is permitted to be withdrawn.

At the oral and joint request of learned counsel for the parties, the main appeal, which is lying admitted, is taken on Board for hearing today itself.

For the reasons stated above, CRM No. 3622 of 2021 is allowed and the applicant-appellant is permitted to withdraw CRA-D No. 901-DB of 2014.
