Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the impugned FIR No.270 dated 13.05.2020, registered under Section 147/148/323/452/506 IPC, at Police Station Surujkund, District Faridabad. Further prayer has been made for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to conduct fair and proper investigation and to register a case on the complaint dated 14.05.2020 (Annexure P-5) by petitioner No.1-Raju.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has argued that the complainant Sunil has falsely implicated the petitioners in the impugned FIR, as the property in question is in the possession of the petitioners. He submits that the complainant has been making attempts to take forcible possession of the property of the petitioners and the civil litigation in that respect is also pending. He submits that despite a representation/complaint given by the petitioners, no case has been registered against the other side.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by the learned

counsel for the petitioners that the investigation in the subject FIR is

pending and the nature of injuries (abrasions) allegedly suffered by the petitioners is simple. A perusal of the impugned FIR reveals that the complainant-Sunil lodged the FIR with the allegations that the petitioners entered in his house and caused injuries to him. According to the complainant, the petitioners were giving threats and attempted to take forcible possession of his land.

After hearing the learned counsel, this Court finds that the investigation in the case is pending, therefore, at this stage, no case is made out for exercise of inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
