The petitioners Balwant Singh and another have filed the present writ petition *inter alia* with a prayer directing the respondents to count the probation service followed by regular service for the purpose of pension, gratuity and other benefits from the date of their appointment.

Learned counsel by making reference to the pleadings submits that petitioner No.1 was appointed on 01.12.1983 as Lecturer in Sanskrit. He was appointed on temporary basis at Shri Krishna College Kanwali, District Mahendergarh (now district Rewari). It is submitted that on 01.09.1984, petitioner was No.1 was appointed on regular basis. Learned counsel submitted that petitioner No.2 is also similarly placed. The prayer thereof of the petitioners is to count their services prior to the date of regular appointment towards pension etc.

Learned counsel submits that for the same/similar grievance, the petitioners have got served a legal notice dated 11.11.2020 (P15).

Without commenting upon the merits of the case and in view of the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to decide claim of the petitioners as contained in the legal notice (P15) by passing a speaking order within 4 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
