Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is being unnecessarily repeatedly called to the police station in order to pressurize her and is being harassed as her son Balkaran Singh, who is out of her control stands involved in FIR No.7 dated 23.01.2021, under Sections 363, 336-A IPC, registered at Police Station Chohla Sahib.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and while refraining from making any expression as regards veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to look into the matter and to ensure that the petitioner is not repeatedly called to the police station. However, in case any information is to be elicited from her

in respect of the aforesaid FIR, a prior written notice be issued to her before calling her.

A copy of this order be sent to respondent No.2 - Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
