Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that his uncle Dilbag Singh (respondent No.5), who is co-owner with the petitioner in the land, which falls under Khewat No.33/31, Khatuni No.81, Khasra No.85(2-4) situated within the revenue estate of Village Theh Tika HB No.402, Tehsil & District Gurdaspur, has sold the land much in excess of his share and that now one Balkar Singh to whom his uncle has sold the land is trying to take forcible possession of the land in question. It has further been submitted that when the petitioner resisted such attempts of his dispossession, respondent No.5 with the help of police got proceedings under Sections 107/151 IPC initiated against the petitioner. It has further been submitted that now the petitioner apprehends threat to his life and liberty at the hands of respondent No.5 and his vendees.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur to look into the matter and to

examine the alleged threat perception of the petitioner. In case, it is found that there is any genuine threat perception, then adequate steps as warranted under law be taken at the earliest so as to ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioner.
