This petition has been filed under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., for grant of 'regular bail' to the petitioner in case FIR No. 75, dated 02.06.2020, registered at Police Station Mehal Kalan, District Barnala, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 21/25/61/85 of the NDPS Act, 1985.

A reply by way of an affidavit of Sh. Kuldeep Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Mehal Kalan, District Barnala, dated 04.09.2021, has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State, which is ordered to be taken on record. A copy thereof be emailed to learned counsel for the petitioner by learned State counsel today itself.

As per the said affidavit, there were 22 criminal cases registered against the petitioner, though he has been acquitted in 03 cases, with him having been convicted in 03 and declared to be a proclaimed offender in 02, with the remaining cases shown to be still under trial.

In the aforesaid circumstances, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case for or against the petitioner, I see no reason to entertain this petition, which is consequently, dismissed.

However, it is again made clear that nothing observed hereinabove will be taken to be a comment on the actual merits of the case for or against the petitioner, which would be wholly gone into as per evidence led before the trial court.
