Matter has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioner who was serving as a Head Constable under the Punjab Police has filed the instant petition assailing the notice dated 11.11.2020 (Annexure P-1), whereby under Rule 3(1)(a)(b) of the Punjab Civil Service (Premature retirement) Rules, 1975, he has been directed to be retired from service on the expiry of three months notice period i.e. w.e.f. 28.02.2021.

An advance copy of the petition already stood served upon the State of Punjab.

Ms. Anu Pal, learned DAG, Punjab informs the Court that the petitioner has had a chequered service record and as such the competent authority has formed an opinion that it would not be in public interest to
