The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.293 dated 09.12.2020, under Sections 353, 186, 332, 341, 148, 149 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City Sunam, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that it is alleged in the FIR that the police officials who had come out of the house of the petitioner were attacked and the uniform was torn. He, however, contends that the police officials had attacked the petitioners and their family members and in the incident, a child was injured.

A Coordinate Bench of this Court, by order dated 16.02.2021 had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Balkar Singh, states that the petitioners have joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioners having joined investigation, the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 16.02.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
