The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing in the light of the pandemic COVID-19 situation and as per instructions.

This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking direction to the respondents to conduct the elections of Ward No.2, Municipal Committee, Morinda, District Rupnagar, scheduled to be held on 14.02.2021, on the basis of basic/final voter list dated 10.12.2020/05.01.2021; to ignore the undated and uncertified supplementary voter list; to supply a signed and certified copy of basic/final voter list dated 10.12.2020/05.01.2021 to the petitioner; and for restraining the respondents from holding the elections in question.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, in case, a copy of the voter list is supplied to him.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from respondent No.5-
Mr. Harpreet Singh Atwal, SDM-cum-Returning Officer, Chamkaur Sahib,
states that as and when the petitioner approaches respondent No.5 during
working hours, a copy of the voter list in question shall be made available to
him.

In view of the above, the instant petition is disposed of in terms
of the statements made by learned counsel for the parties.
