Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No. 424 dated 21.12.2019 registered under Sections 323, 34, 341, 342, 379-A, 427, 506 IPC at Police Station Chandimandir, District Panchkula.

The operative part of the order dated 07.02.2020, vide which the petitioners have been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the complainant Kushpreet Kaur is the wife of petitioner No.1 – Amandeep Singh and at the time of the incident, she was travelling with her friend Rajeev Kumar where the accused persons have assaulted her near a Toll Plaza. It is further submitted that both the complainant and the aforesaid Rajeev Kumar are having extra-marital affairs to which the petitioner No.1 was objecting and on that

account, he has been falsely implicated. Counsel for the petitioners has relied upon the Whatsapp conversation between the complainant and Rajeev Kumar to submit that they are having intimate relationship.

Notice of motion for 16.04.2020.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners, in pursuance to the order dated 07.02.2020, have already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Harvinder Singh, assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 07.02.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
