Through this writ petition, the petitioners are praying for a writ of mandamus by way of directions to the respondent Nos.1 to 3 for protecting their lives from respondent Nos.4 to 11 as they have performed marriage against their wishes.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioners solemnized marriage on 03.02.2021 and they are facing threats from the family members of petitioner No.1-Amandeep Kaur. She submits that on the same same day i.e.03.02.2021, a representation was given to the Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), District Patiala, but till date no action has been taken upon the same. She has further argued that the brother of petitioner No.1-Happi (respondent No.4) is against this alliance as he is interested in the Fixed Deposit of Rs.80,000/- lying in the account of petitioner No.1. She submits that the necessary directions be issued to the official respondents for providing protection to the petitioners.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by learned counsel that petitioner No.2 is already married but according to her, he

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioners and perusing the representation, this Court finds that the apprehension expressed by the petitioners is vague and lacks necessary particulars. The representation neither contains the name of the private respondents nor the manner and mode of alleged threat has been described. The averments made in the petitioner do not inspire any confidence, therefore, this Court does not find it to be a fit case for exercise of extra ordinary writ jurisdiction.

Dismissed.
