The petitioners have filed this petition under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty, as they apprehend danger from respondents No.4 to 6, who are against the marriage of the petitioners.

On 24.2.2021, learned State counsel sought time to verify the existence of alleged threat.

Reply by way of affidavit of Mohan Dass, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division, Abohar, District Fazilka, has been filed by learned State counsel wherein both the petitioners got recorded their respective statements on 1.3.2021 (Annexure R-1/T & R-2/T) and stated that they do not apprehend any danger from anyone. Respondents No.4 to 6 have also got recorded their respective statements dated 1.3.2021 (Annexure R-3/T to R-5/T) and stated that they have no objection to their marriage.

Learned counsel for the petitioners does not dispute this fact and submits that in view of the statements of the petitioners as well as respondents No.4 to 6, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
