As per report received from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, the parties have amicably settled their dispute.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after having compromised the matter, the parties have also filed a joint petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act wherein their first motion statements have been recorded. He further submits that in the wake of the matter having been amicably settled, the parties have also preferred a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the FIR in question on the basis of compromise.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2/complainant does not dispute the submissions made by the counsel opposite qua the parties having indeed arrived at an amicable settlement and a joint petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act having been filed.

Learned State counsel, submits that in compliance of order dated 08.09.2021, the petitioner has already joined investigation and he is not required for further investigation.

In view of above, order dated 08.09.2021 granting interim bail to petitioner, is made absolute. Petitioner shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
