The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.150 dated 21.09.2020 under Section 379 IPC and Sections 3, 13(1) of the Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act, 2015, registered at Police Station Pratap Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 23.09.2020 and trial in the case is not likely to be concluded in the near future. He further submits that co-accused Tarikh and Danish have already been admitted on bail vide order dated 11.02.2021 passed by this Court in CRM-M-2249-2021(Tarikh Versus State of

Haryana) and **CRM-M-40281-2020(Danish Versus State of Haryana)**, respectively and the allegation against the present petitioner are similar to co-accused Danish and Tarikh.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Suresh Chand, does not dispute the custody period of the petitioner and the fact that co-accused have been admitted on bail by this Court.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

It is the conceded position that co-accused Tarikh and Danish have already been admitted on bail by this Court vide order dated 11.02.2021. The petitioner is in custody since 23.09.2020. Trial in the case is not likely to be concluded in the near future, thus, this Court deems it appropriate to admit the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
