The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 188 dated 07.11.2020, under Sections 147, 149, 323, 452 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' – for short) (Section 325 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Baragudha, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that it is a case of version and cross-version, as two persons from the petitioners' side had also received injuries. He also contends that the incident is the outcome of a sudden quarrel between the residents of the same village. All the injuries are simple except an injury on the little finger of the right hand of the complainant. He also contends that the petitioners are 18 years of age and are not involved in any other criminal case. He also contends that the petitioners will try to settle the matter amicably.

This Court, by the order dated 17.02.2021, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation

and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Satyawar, states that the petitioners have joined investigation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 17.02.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
