The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.457 dated 01.08.2020 under Sections 307, 147, 148, 149, 323, 324, 326, 201, 506 and 341 IPC, registered at Police Station City Sirsa, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the petitioner had given a *gandasi* blow on the head of the injured-Vikram who has fully recovered from the injury. The petitioner is in custody for almost a year since his arrest on 20.08.2020. He also contends that co-accused Sanny has been granted regular bail by this Court in CRM-M-18275 of 2021, on 22.07.2021.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Vishal, states that although challan has been filed but no prosecution witness has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the above especially when the petitioner is in custody for almost a year, the Covid-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Pending application, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
