The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.05 dated 06.01.2021 under Sections 498-A, 406, 313, 506 and 120-B IPC 1860 registered at Police Station Civil Lines Batala District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the FIR in question emanates from a matrimonial dispute between the parties, however, subsequently the matter was amicably settled between them. This Court has also been apprised that the petition for quashing of said FIR has already been filed before this Court and the parties have been directed to get their statements recorded with respect to the compromise arrived at between them. He further submits that pursuant to order dated 17.02.2021, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation. This fact is not disputed by the counsel for the State as well.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Harpal Singh states that the petitioner is no longer required for further interrogation.

Learned State counsel also does not dispute the factum of seeking quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise having been filed before this Court.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 17.02.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
