The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after registration of FIR on 02.06.2019, petitioner has solemnized marriage with Veerpal Kaur by way of Anand Karaj on 23.12.2020 and now, he is living with his wife.

Petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender by the concerned Court on 27.08.2019 and he has not assailed the said order as yet.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the concerned Court and in the event of his surrendering and applying for regular bail, the same be ordered to be decided at the earliest.

There is no scope for entertaining the prayer for anticipatory bail, however, in the event of surrendering and applying for regular bail by the petitioner, the same shall be decided at the earliest in accordance with law.
