The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Petitioners Navjot Kaur and Paramjit Kaur have filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.50 dated 30.04.2019 under Section 326-B read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the order dated 17.02.2021 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Bodh Raj, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioners is not required in the case.

Heard.

Since the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated February 17, 2021 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
