Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail, pending trial in case NCB No.20 dated 30.04.2018, under Sections 8 and 20 N.D.P.S.Act, 1985, registered at Police Station, NCB, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of Narcotics Control Bureau, Chandigarh has pointed out that the petitioner was arrested for having in his possession 4 kgs.100 grams of charas, and after commencement of trial, five prosecution witnesses have already been examined out of total nine witnesses. He further states that two witnesses have been summoned for 28.11.2021 and the trial is at an advanced stage.

Faced with this stand of the learned counsel for NCB, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press with petition and wishes to withdraw the same.
