Having heard learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court that in case the petitioners surrender before the trial Court within 10 days from today and move an application for grant of regular bail in the forenoon of the day, the trial Court shall endeavour to dispose of the same expeditiously, preferably on the day of filing of such application itself while noticing all the contentions of the petitioners including the contention to the effect that it is basically a case arising out of property dispute wherein the matter had earlier been enquired into thoroughly on two occasions i.e. once by DSP and once by SIT and the allegations have been found to be false and cancellation report against some of the co-accused has already been accepted and while also keeping in view the fact that the only offence other than SC&ST Act, is an offence under Section 323 IPC, which is a bailable offence.
