The petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No.357 dated 23.12.2020 registered under Sections 384/406 IPC at Police Station Safidon, District Jind.

The operative part of the order dated 24.02.2021, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a lady aged about 66 years, who is housewife and has been involved in the case on account of rivalry between her sons and the complainant.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 24.02.2021, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has been released on interim bail. It is also submitted
