By way of the present petition, the petitioner has sought the relief of issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to declare that she had passed PSTET (Punjab State Teacher Eligibility Test) in B.C category and to issue the requisite certificate to her in respect thereof and she has further prayed for issuing direction to the respondents to consider her for her appointment on the post of Mistress of Social Science subject, as advertised vide Annexure P-1 and/or to decide her representation dated 11.02.2020 (Annexure P-9), while averring that she had secured the requisite minimum marks in the above-said test for being eligible for the issuance of such certificate.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Nikhil K. Chopra, Additional A.G. Punjab, who has appeared in this case in pursuance of the copies of this petition having

been sent to the respondents-State in advance, accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to look into and decide her said representation dated 11.02.2020 (Annexure P-9) within some specific time frame.

Learned State counsel has no objection for the same.

Keeping in view the above-discussed limited prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting upon the merits of the matter in hand, the present writ petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Director, State Council of Education, Research & Training, Punjab, to look into and decide the said representation of the petitioner dated 11.02.2020 (Annexure P-9) in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order thereon, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

This petition stands disposed of accordingly.
