Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 167 dated 09.10.2020, under Sections 498-A, 406 of IPC registered at Police Station Gharinda, District Amritsar.

By virtue of the order dated 23.02.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute. He has further submitted that the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. However the same could not be materialized.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajdeep

Singh has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 23.02.2021, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
