The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.101 dated 20.11.2020 under Sections 323, 324, 326, 336, 506, 201, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Sehna, District Tapa, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the petitioner had given an axe blow on the ankle of the complainant who has fully recovered from the injury. He also contends that the petitioner is in custody for about eight months since his arrest on 04.12.2020.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Makhan Lal, states that although challan has been filed but no prosecution witness has been examined. He has filed reply by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Tapa, District Barnala in Court through e-mail, which is taken on record.

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Heard.

In view of the above especially when the petitioner is in custody for about eight months, the Covid-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
