The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.403 dated 27.11.2020, under Section 22(b) of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Dabwali Sadar, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the alleged recovery which has been effected from the petitioner is 202 grams Tramadol which is non-commercial quantity. He also contends that the petitioner is in custody for about three months.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Shalender Kumar, contends that although challan has been filed but no prosecution witness has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the above especially when the recovery is of non-commercial quantity, the petitioner is in custody for about three months, the COVID-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
