1. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that in view of compliance report dated 01.03.2021 having been furnished by the respondent along with speaking order dated 24.02.2021, the contempt petition may be disposed of as not calling for any further orders. Copy of the compliance report dated 01.03.2021 is taken on record.

2. Mr. Aditya Sharda, AAG, Punjab states that non compliance within the stipulated period of time was not intentional but due to administrative exigencies on account of circumstances prevailing on account of coronavirus pandemic and in view of compliance report dated 01.03.2021 having been supplied along with speaking order dated 24.02.2021, the contempt petition be disposed of as not calling for any orders.

3. I have considered the submissions of learned counsel and am of the view that in the circumstances, non compliance within the stipulated period of time was not intentional or willful.

4. In view of the position noted above, Rule is discharged and the Contempt Petition is disposed of as not calling for any further orders.
