This is an application for impleading Surinder Pal as
respondent No.2.

Notice of this application was issued for today.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has no serious
objection for impleadment of Surinder Pal as party- respondent
No.2.

In view of above, Surinder Pal is impleaded as
respondent No.2.

Application stands disposed of.

Main case

Petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.15 dated 22.01.2020 registered under Sections 379, 447, 511 IPC at Police Station Machiwara, Police District Khanna.

On 07.02.2020, following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that in the civil suit filed by petitioner No.1, order of status quo was granted on 31.7.2019. Even if the prosecution story is believed on its face value, the same would give rise to civil consequences as the petitioners are also co-sharer in the land in question.

Notice of motion for 16.04.2020.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 11.02.2020 at 11.00 a.m. and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions as

envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Tejinder Singh submits that in compliance of order dated 07.02.2020, the petitioners have joined the investigation to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer and they are no more required in further investigation of the case.

In view of above, order dated 07.02.2020 is hereby made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so by the Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
