GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

Petitioner-Kuldeep Singh, stated to be aged 48 years, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for modification of order dated 01.02.2021 (Annexure P-6), passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division), Amritsar, whereby the application under Order 39 Rule 1 & 2, filed by the petitioner for seeking stay, has not been decided.

Records of the case show that on 23.02.2021, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Petitioner-Kuldeep Singh stated to be aged 48 years has filed the present civil revision petition inter alia with a prayer for modification of order dated 01.02.2021 passed

by the Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Amritsar (Annexure P-6) whereby the application filed by the petitioner under Order 39 Rule 1 & 2 for seeking stay has not been decided and further for grant of ad-interim injunction to the petitioner against the respondents.

Notice of motion be issued for 05.04.2021.”

Today, on the resumed hearing of the case, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the main suit which was pending before the trial Court, has been withdrawn and accordingly the present petition has become infructuous.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondents has not disputed the statement made by counsel for the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present Civil Revision Petition is dismissed as having become infructuous.
