ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.158 dated 09.07.2020, under Sections 307, 323, 324, 341, 148, 149, registered at Police Station Ghuman, District Batala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been attributed a solitary injury on the foot of the son of the complainant namely Jitender Singh which was found to be simple in nature. The petitioner is 25 years of age and is not involved in any other criminal case. He also contends that similarly situated co-accused namely Palwinder Singh has been granted anticipatory bail by the Coordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-22879-2020 on 16.10.2020.

This Court, by the order dated 18.02.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from Sub Inspector Darshan Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 18.02.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
