The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to
Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of
Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 408 dated
24.12.2019, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the
Indian Penal Code, 1860 and under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act,
1914, at Police Station Nangal Chaudhri, District Mahendergarh.

On 20.02.2020, the following orders were passed:-

*“Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the
truck bearing No.RJ18-GB-1109 from which recovery of
liquor was effected was originally in the name of the
petitioner but he sold it to one Sunil by virtue of agreement to
sell dated 22.11.2019 and also passed on the possession of
the truck to him.*

Notice of motion for 24.03.2020.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, upon instructions, from ASI Hari Parkash submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above fact, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. Order dated 20.02.2020 is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
