Petitioner has filed this writ petition being aggrieved of the respondents granting Child Care Leave of only 61 days whereas it is contended that she applied for Child Care Leave from 20.01.2019 to 19.01.2021.

While issuing notice of motion on 05.02.2019, it was ordered that the petitioner would continue on Child Care Leave till the next date of hearing and the interim order continued. CM-18817-CWP-2021 has been filed seeking withdrawal of the writ petition with the averments that the petitioner has in fact rejoined on her post, therefore, she seeks to withdraw this writ petition which is rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Mr. Harish Kumar, Deputy Superintendent, Secretary Education, Haryana, verifies that the petitioner had joined her duties on 08.05.2020.

At request and with consent of learned counsel for the parties,
hearing of this writ petition is preponed from 06.07.2022 for today itself.

Learned counsel for the State does not raise any objection to
withdrawal of the writ petition.

Application is allowed and writ petition is accordingly
dismissed as withdrawn.
