By way of the present petition, the petitioners seek the relief of issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to take action on the application dated 04.03.2020 (Annexure P-15) within some specified time and to allot the alternative land to them, while averring that they had moved the afore-said application in pursuance of the order dated 13.01.2020 as passed by this Court in LPA No.1387 of 2019 while dismissing the same as having been withdrawn and granting liberty to them to file the said application before the authorities for allotment of alternative land to them.

Mr. S.S.Pannu, DAG, Haryana, has joined the proceedings in pursuance of the copy of this petition having been sent to the respondents-State in advance.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied in case a direction is given to respondent

No.1 to decide their said application (Annexure P-15) within some specific time.

Learned State counsel has no objection for the same.

Keeping in view the afore-discussed limited prayer of learned counsel for the petitioners and without commenting upon the merits of the matter in hand, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1, i.e. the Secretary-cum-Financial Commissioner, Department of Revenue, Haryana, to consider and decide the afore-said application of the petitioners (Annexure P-15) strictly in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
