By means of this writ petition under Articles 226 Constitution of India, petitioners have prayed for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6.

On 18.02.2021, the following order was passed by this Court:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are receiving threats from respondent Nos.4 to 6 as they have entered into marriage on 09.02.2021 against their wishes.

Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 3 only, at this stage.

Ms. Monika Jalota, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of official respondents. Counsel for the petitioners undertakes to forward the complete copy of the petition to the office of Advocate General Punjab through e-mail, during the course of the day.

Learned State counsel prays for time to verify the facts and the existence of alleged threat.

On his request, adjourned to 05.04.2021.”

Today, learned State counsel has produced short reply by way of affidavit of Palwinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-

private respondents and submitted that they are not opposing the alleged marriage of the petitioners, who have not returned to the house.

Today, no one has appeared on behalf of the petitioners.

In view of the statements of the private respondents, nothing survives for adjudication in this petition.

Dismissed as infructuous.
