The only prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner is for issuance of a direction to respondent No.1 to decide the second appeal preferred by the petitioner challenging the order passed by respondent No.2 in pursuance of clause 14 of the Transportation Policy of food grains for the years 2020-21 which has not been decided as yet.

Learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the respondent-State of Punjab submits that the second appeal filed by the petitioner shall be considered and decided expeditiously in accordance with law within a period of three weeks.

In view of the aforesaid statement made by learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the respondent-State of Punjab, the petition stands disposed of. It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case and therefore, the authorities would be at liberty to examine the matter keeping all facts and facets into consideration and thereafter accept or reject the same in accordance with law.
