Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.305 dated 16.08.2019 under Sections 323, 354, 506 and 34 IPC registered at Police Station City Jhajjar, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 25.02.2020, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Inspector Narsingh submits that no doubt petitioner has joined the investigation, however, there are serious allegations levelled against the petitioner of trying to take the prosecutrix by pushing her into a running vehicle as a result of which she received injuries. She has further apprised the Court that soon after the alleged occurrence the prosecutrix was medico-legally examined and the injuries, which were seen on her person, corroborate the version given by the prosecutrix in the FIR in question. It has also been submitted that the petitioner is one of the two anti-social elements, who had been continuously

indulging in inappropriate behaviour and in eve teasing the prosecutrix.

Heard.

Prima facie, there are serious and specific allegations levelled against the petitioner for which he does not deserve the concession of anticipatory bail. Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
