Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

At the very outset, learned State counsel submits that petitioner has been declared a Proclaimed Offender in the present FIR and despite that his arrest has been stayed. Submissions made by learned State counsel have not been denied by learned counsel for the petitioner. Learned State counsel further submits that there are 3 more cases against the petitioner out of which one case is under Section 307 I.P.C.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition, however, petitioner may be granted some protection to enable him to surrender before the concerned court.

In view of the above circumstances, present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to appear before the concerned court within a period of one week from today. In case he surrenders within this

period, he shall be provided protection from arrest for three days only. In case of non-compliance of the direction, the benefit of this order will not be available to the petitioner. Trial Court will be at liberty to take into consideration all the attending circumstances.

The observations made in this order will not have any bearing on the merits of the case.
