The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.388 dated 16.09.2019 registered under Sections 147, 149, 323, 307, 341, 506, 120-B IPC at Police Station Azad Nagar, Hisar, District Hisar.

On 11.02.2020, following order was passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court:-

“Submits inter alia that this is a case of scuffle between two groups and the injuries were suffered by members of both groups.

Notice of motion for 08.07.2020.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioners by the Arresting/Investigating Officer, they shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

1. That they shall make themselves available for interrogation by a Police Officer as and when required;
2. That they shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any Police Officer and;
3. That they shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Hari Mohan admitted the aforesaid fact and submitted that the petitioners are no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 11.02.2020 is made absolute. Petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
