

effected between the parties and the same is without any pressure or coercion and out of their free will. The trial Court has annexed the copy of statements of the parties alongwith its report.

Learned State counsel also submits that there are no other accused other than the petitioners and respondent Nos.2 to 4 are the only aggrieved persons in the FIR in question.

In view of the report of the learned JMIC, Kapurthala and the principles laid down by the Apex Court in *Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303*, and also by the Full Bench of this Court in *Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052*, the instant petition is allowed. The aforesaid report and all consequential proceedings arising out of it, are quashed.

Needless to say the parties shall remain bound by the terms of compromise and their statements recorded before the Court below.
