The petitioners have invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to grant family pension to the petitioner in a time bound manner, on account of demise of her husband, who had retired from Department of State Transport, Haryana and was receiving pension after retirement as the family pension of petitioner is not being released by the respondents despite the application dated 15.07.2020 (Annexure P-1).
