On 12.03.2020, the following order was passed by this

Court:-

“Briefly, an FIR bearing No. 2 dated 5.1.2020, under Section 306/34 IPC at Police Station Badhra, District Charkhi Dadri has been registered on the basis of the statement of Rashveer as his brother namely Satish had committed suicide on 4.1.2020. The allegations against the petitioner are to the effect that his daughter Tanu was married with the deceased. As per the FIR, the allegation against the petitioner is to the effect that on 6.12.2019 he came to the house of the deceased, threatened him and incited his daughter that there is no need to fear. However, the suicide has been committed after a time gap of about one month.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record copy of the communication on mobile phone

between the deceased and his brother after consumption of the mobile. However, the communication does not indicate that the petitioner has been specifically named therein.

Adjourned to 21.5.2020.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Pawan Kumar, Police Station Badhra, District Charkhi Dadri, submits that the cancellation report was submitted before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 31.08.2020 and the same has been accepted on 11.12.2020.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous.
