The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

The petitioner has filed this criminal writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction to the respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, who is injured-eye witness/prosecution witness in case FIR No.227 dated 19.11.2020 under Sections 302 and 307 read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Division No.3, Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that for the relief claimed in the present petition, the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 28.01.2021 (Annexure P-2) to the respondents, but no action has been taken thereon till date.

He further states that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondent No.2 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to decide the aforesaid representation dated 28.01.2021 (Annexure P-2).

Notice of motion.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Avtar Singh Sandhu, Additional Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Heard.

Without making any observation as regard the claim so made in the present petition, but considering the limited prayer of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to take note of the representation dated 28.01.2021 (Annexure P-2) and to act in accordance with law.
