1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Learned counsel contends that petitioner No.1 had married petitioner No.2 against the wishes of her family members and in view thereof, the petitioners had moved the instant petition seeking protection of their life and liberty at the hands of her family members. However, now she has amicably settled the matter with her family members i.e. respondent Nos.4 to 9 and has moved a petition under Section 13B of the Hindu Marriage Act for divorce by mutual consent and the said case is listed for hearing on 05.10.2021 and further that now petitioner No.1 is residing with her family members i.e. respondent Nos. 4 to 9, therefore, the petitioners do not wish to pursue the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

3. The same is not opposed by the learned State counsel.

4. Accordingly, in view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
