Petitioner No.1-Jugraj Singh is stated to have been born on 10.06.1981 in village Ilmewala, Tehsil Zira, District Ferozepur. Petitioner No.2-Kamaljit Kaur is stated to be the wife of petitioner No.1. Petitioner No.1 is stated to have gone for employment purposes in the year 2001 to Republic of Kenya, acquired the citizenship of Kenya in the year 2009 due to compelling circumstances while relinquishing his Indian Passport. Petitioner is stated to have been issued a Kenyan Passport No.B065590 on 22.12.2009 valid upto 21.12.2019. Petitioner No.1 upon obtaining an Indian Visa issued on 30.12.2014 valid upto 29.06.2015 is stated to have entered into India

on 15.02.20215 and since then continued to reside in India with his family.

By filing the present writ petition challenge has been laid to the Notice dated 18.01.2021 (P-2) issued by The Foreigners Regional Registration Officer, Bureau of Immigration, Amritsar-respondent no.2, whereby SSP Ferozepur was directed to initiate action against the petitioner no.1 for overstaying in India, including the steps to deport him.

Prayer *inter alia* is for restoring the Indian Citizenship to petitioner no.1.

At the time of hearing realising that the necessary provisions of the relevant Statute and Rules have not been reproduced, learned Counsel for the petitioners prays for permission to withdraw the present writ petition to enable his clients to file fresh one with better particulars.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
