Present contempt petition has been filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India due to not implementing the order dated 13.02.2020 (P-1) passed by this Court in CWP No. 19719 of 2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the service of the petitioner from 08.03.1973 till her superannuation i.e. 30.06.2005 has been treated as qualifying service for the purpose of pension.

In view thereof, the present petition has become infructuous and is disposed of accordingly, it would be open for the petitioner to revive the present contempt petition in case the necessary pensionary benefits are not released within two months.
