The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.403 dated 02.10.2019 registered under Sections 21/61 of NDPS Act at Police Station Rania, District Sirsa.

On 10.02.2020, following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that 12 gms of heroin is alleged to have been recovered from Jangir Singh along with a motorcycle. In the disclosure statement

of said Jangir Singh, name of the petitioner has come to fore to the effect that Jangir Singh had purchased the said contraband from the petitioner.

Notice of motion for 22.4.2020.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 18.2.2020 at 11.00 a.m. and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in compliance of order dated 10.02.2020.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Anil Kumar admits the aforesaid fact and submits that he is no more required in further investigation of the case.

In view of above, order dated 10.02.2020 is hereby made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so by the Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
