Writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing impugned charge-sheet dated 29.01.2020 (P-6) as well as the transfer order dated 26.12.2019 (P-8).

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioner, apprised the Court that impugned charge-sheet has been dropped by the respondents; thus, the petition qua that extent is rendered infructuous.

However, with regard to the impugned transfer order, it is submitted that although, the same was modified subsequently on 23.07.2021 (P-9), but representation dated 05.10.2021 (P-10) thereagainst is still pending for consideration. Also submitted that in case, his request is decided in a time-bound manner, he would be satisfied.

Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without

going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to the concerned quarter i.e. The Director, Public Instructions (Elementary), Vidya Bhawan (Punjab School Education Board), Phase VIII, SAS Nagar, Mohali-respondent No.2, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation, within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Since the main petition has been decided, therefore, pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off accordingly.
